XI. Public Hearing – Public comment after each item below

1. Revised Section 2.02 – Definitions; refined wording for Clubs
2. Revised Section 3.03 – Animals – expansion to enable maintenance of chickens. Emails and letters from several property owners both in favor and against the ordinance were reviewed
 - Public Comments – there is currently a rooster on a property within the township that is not zoned Agricultural. Suggested contacting Robert Frank, Zoning Administrator, to address the issue
 - Concerns over chickens wandering onto neighboring properties were voiced. Recommendation to refer issue to the Zoning Administrator if a resolution could not be attained from working with the chicken owner.
 - Lots of discussion about having chickens on lake front property and the possibility of chicken waste getting into the lake.
 - A property owner that also owns property in Massachusetts commented that it was nice to hear discussion where all of the participants were respectful and non-confrontational even if they had different viewpoints.
3. Adding Section 3.23 Clubs
4. Revised Section 4.12.2.16 Include “Clubs” as a permitted use in Commercial & Industrial District

XII. Old Business

1. Data Center discussion – Moratorium and potential zoning updates
 - Public Comment – general agreement that a Data Center is not wanted in the township. Glad that the 9 month moratorium was approved and that we are working on ordinances that will address utilities, water usage, noise, light pollution and environmental concerns. The proposed notional schedule for addressing the Data Center Zoning Ordinances (DCZO) was reviewed and everyone was comfortable with the timing. A suggestion was made that if it got to the point where the clearing of land was done to accommodate a Data Center and then it was not built that the company building it would be responsible for restoring the property.
 - Public Hearing was closed at 9:57 am
